

NHMRC-Global Alliance for Chronic Diseases (GACD): Non-Communicable Disease Prevention in Cities Funding Call 2023

The Global Alliance for Chronic Diseases (GACD) is a collaboration between major international research funding agencies that support joint funding calls and research capacity building activities to address chronic, non-communicable diseases (NCD).

The objective of the NHMRC-GACD 2023 scheme is to fund implementation research focused on addressing NCD risk factors associated with city environments and related health inequities in Low- and Middle-Income Countries and/or in populations facing conditions of vulnerability in High-Income Countries.
